

Open the .csv-file in Excel

Open the .csv-file in Excel

The readings of the [Shelly EM](#) are stored in a **.csv-file**. To open this file in about **Excel**, it is advantageous to save them first on the disk. Opening directly while in Windows Explorer results in a rather unreadable Excel spreadsheet.

More professional is the following process:

- Save .csv-file to disk, **DO NOT open**, assign appropriate name
- Open Excel
- In the tab menu on "data", here "from text"
- Upcoming window "Import text-file", here you can select the previously saved .csv-file -> "Open"
- Now the .csv-file appears as a very readable Excel spreadsheet.
